



Event Guidelines for September 21st

We look forward to your participation in Vashti Center's upcoming 6th **annual Dinner On The Bricks** on **Saturday, September 21, 2019!** A special thank you to our presenting sponsor, **FLOWERS AUTOMOTIVE GROUP!**

To ensure all patrons have a pleasurable experience at this event, we ask that you adhere to the following event guidelines. Please print and share this information with your table guests.

Alcoholic Beverages:

- **Alcohol (please read carefully):** Beginning at 6 p.m., beer and wine will be available for purchase at designated stations, in the special event area. Patrons must first present ID at the registration table to receive a wrist band and designated cup authorized by the City. **Per City of Thomasville regulations for nonprofit special events, no alcohol may be brought into the event. "Brown bagging" of any kind is prohibited.** No alcoholic beverage purchased within the event area **shall be allowed to leave or be consumed outside the event area.** Patrons are not permitted to purchase beer/wine outside the designated station and bring it to the event area.

Tables:

- **Table décor should be completed by 6 p.m. to qualify for judging.** If you are competing in the table decoration contest, your table number must remain visible until judging is completed. Winners will be given an award and have their picture taken.
- Tents of any kind and glassware are not permitted.
- Open flames and candles are not allowed, with the exception of Sterno used for chafing dishes. Battery operated lighting is permitted.
- Refrain from placing any decorations or serving apparatus on the sidewalk and street. Each patron will be assigned the use of ½ of a serving table (table cloth included) for serving apparatus, coolers, and storage underneath.
- Decorations are limited to **TABLE TOPS AND CHAIRS ONLY.** There will be no room to expand outside this permitted area. Electric power will not be provided to patrons. Please do not elevate your table.
- Removal or modification of the table provided for the event is prohibited. If you do not wish to use the white, knee-length tablecloth provided, please return it to the registration table.
- Tables have been assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Swapping of table numbers at the time of the event is prohibited. Tables may not be resold or transferred to another party without approval by the Dinner On The Bricks Committee.

Event Area:

- Thomasville’s Ritz Amphitheater off of W. Jackson St. in downtown Thomasville!
- **Access to the event area opens at 3 p.m. This includes registration, table set-up and decoration.**
- Parking: Trinity Anglican Church Parking lot, West Jackson Street, Remington Avenue, Madison Street, Public Library, Corner of West Jackson and Stevens Streets, and parking lot behind the dialysis center on 300 West Jackson St.
- The event ends promptly at 10 p.m. Tables must be cleared by 10:20 p.m. Please clear your table completely, leaving the white table cloth provided. Kindly prevent litter by using the trash receptacles provided by the City.
- The Vashti Center and the City of Thomasville are not responsible for any property damaged, stolen, or left by attendees or their caterers. Items unclaimed at the end of the evening will be discarded.
